



5.2 Environmental Policy

LPL Construction Services (the 'Organisation') recognises the importance of environmental protection and is committed to operating its business responsibly and in compliance with all environmental regulations, legislation and approved professional codes of practice relating to building and civil engineering. This must be an on-going process of improvement to both goods and services provided and must include internal housekeeping.

It is the Organisation's objective to operate with, and to maintain good relations with all regulatory bodies, and comply with all applicable legal requirements. LPL Construction's policy on environmental issues will carry out all measures reasonably practicable, to involve all staff assess the cost benefit of any decisions and facilitate the ability to continually improve environmental performance. We will publicise our efforts wherever possible, and strive for:

- Reduction in waste arising from surplus and damaged materials by accurate measuring and greater care.
- Reduction in packaging by pre-fabrication and returns to suppliers.
- Reduction in energy by pre-planning and improved utilisation of resources.
- Avoiding the use of environmentally hazardous substances by design or substitution.
- Improving efficiency by production planning, maintenance and by replacing worn equipment.
- Reduction in waste materials by recycling concrete, aggregates, timber, glass and metal, paper & cardboard.
- Avoiding contamination of the watercourse by container bunding and care when filling machinery that is regularly maintained.
- Reduction in harmful emissions by continuous investment in new vehicles and machinery whilst also reducing the engine revolutions or switching off whilst not in use.

This policy is communicated to all employees, suppliers and sub-contractors and is made available to the public. All personnel understand their obligations under this policy statement and abide with the principals and contents of the Environmental Management System Manual. The Organisation constantly monitors and reviews its environmental performance.

This Policy will be reviewed annually or whenever any significant change occurs within the organisation or whenever any legislative change requires and will have impact upon the policy.
