1. INTRODUCTION

Loppingdale Plant Limited t/a LPL Construction Services (LPL) has produced this statement to set out our commitment to compliance with the Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2015 (CDM 2015) and to guide our designers, contractors and delivery partners.

It demonstrates how LPL meets its duties on any project where CDM 2015 applies, whether we are appointed as Principal Contractor, Contractor or Designer.

2. OUR CDM 2015 COMMITMENTS

With reference to CDM 2015, LPL will:

- Meet the requirements of CDM 2015 and discharge the duties of whichever role we hold on a project, whether as Principal Contractor, Contractor or Designer.
- Eliminate or reduce risks and hazards from the earliest planning and design stage by applying the general principles of prevention.
- Appoint individuals, and engage a supply chain, with the skills, knowledge, experience and organisational capability needed for their role.
- Ensure our designers, subcontractors and wider supply chain understand their duties under CDM 2015 and are trained to identify hazards and to remove, reduce or manage risks.
- Prepare, maintain and share the construction phase plan, and contribute to the pre-construction information and health and safety file, so that accurate information flows to everyone who needs it.
- Cooperate and coordinate with the Client, Principal Designer and other dutyholders, and provide welfare facilities in line with Schedule 2 when acting as Principal Contractor.

- Highlight hazards in a clear and easy to understand format, and ensure Senior Managers attend CDM training to maintain competence and to brief all personnel involved.
- Ensure the Client is aware of their duties under Part 2, Regulation 4 of CDM 2015, including the requirement to notify the HSE (Regulation 6) on notifiable projects.
